Welcome and Introductions ( <i>Jalu Xiong</i> )	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Welcomed new community partners Yuri Kimura and Annette Jumper</li> </ul>
Overview of Workgroup ( <i>Jalu Xiong</i> )	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The S1 Workgroup is designed to do a deep dive into Maltreatment in Foster Care in order to improve protection of the youth in our care.</li> <li>Currently our performance is as low as 6.25 Incidents per 100,000 days in care, which is performing better than the State (7.81) and the National Standard (8.3). This is a noticeable improvement over recent performance, where our rate was over 16.</li> <li>The goal of the workgroup is to continue to look at how to reduce maltreatment in foster care.</li> </ul>
Selection of New Co-Chair (All)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The previous community partner co-chair took a job with a new agency and is unable to continue in the role.</li> <li>A new community partner co-chair is sought.</li> <li>The co-chair will work along with Jalu to plan the agendas and facilitate future meetings along with additional communications between meetings.</li> <li>Peter Bell inquired about the length of term for the position. It is voluntary and if plans change, you're free to step down.</li> <li>Peter Bell agreed to be co-chair and was thanked by those in attendance.</li> </ul>
