Dear Representative Matsui:

On behalf of the Sacramento County Adult and Aging Commission, I am writing this letter of support for the Sacramento County Department of Transportation (SacDOT) Pedestrian Wayfinding Pilot Project application for Federal FY 2024 Appropriations Requests – Community Project Requests. The Sacramento County Adult and Aging Commission is made up of county residents (at least half of whom are 50 or older) who track aging and disability trends, advocate for expanded and improved services, and listen to input from service providers and the public.

This pilot project aims to provide pedestrians real time information regarding the accessibility of sidewalks, most especially for groups encompassing those who face mobility challenges, i.e. senior citizens and people with disabilities. Through the mobile application, both individuals who walk and roll will learn in advance where sidewalks are located, the slope of sidewalks, location of curb ramps, tripping hazards, and major obstructions, and thus plan their routes according to their specific mobility needs. At selected major roadways, the app user will be able to request an extended pedestrian minimum green time from a smart traffic signal in order to have enough time to cross the street.

This will be the first deployment of a pedestrian mobile wayfinding app in the United States, which goes beyond using centerline data and instead utilizes sidewalk data, helping our most vulnerable residents to walk and roll more safely. With the lack of wayfinding for pedestrians and the steady climb in the country's aging population, this mobile app provides an opportunity to promote self-sufficiency for underserved groups through the transportation sector. By providing information on whether a route is connected and accessible, we will increase opportunities for exercise among seniors and people with disabilities, allowing for more safe and seamless trips to community destinations for all.

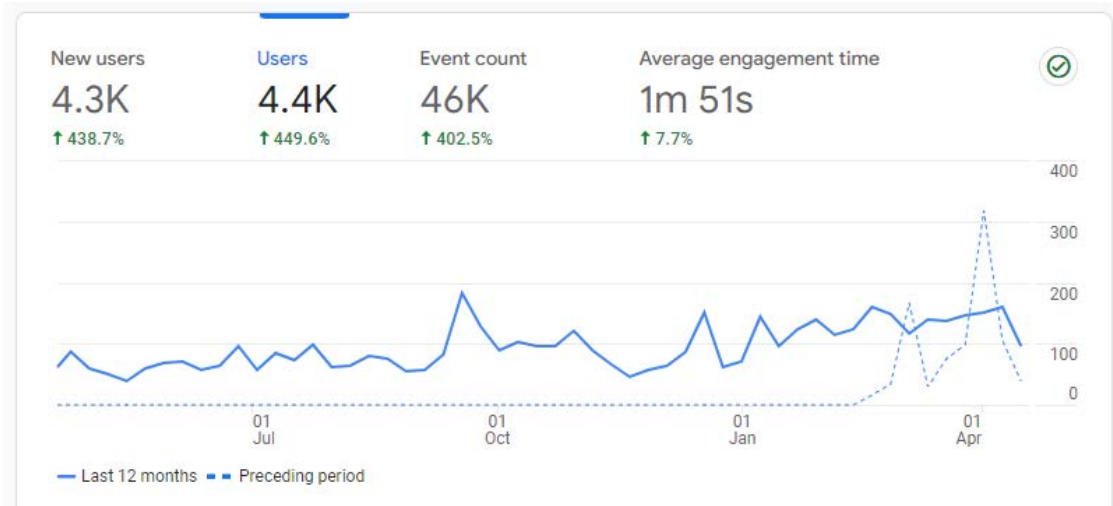
