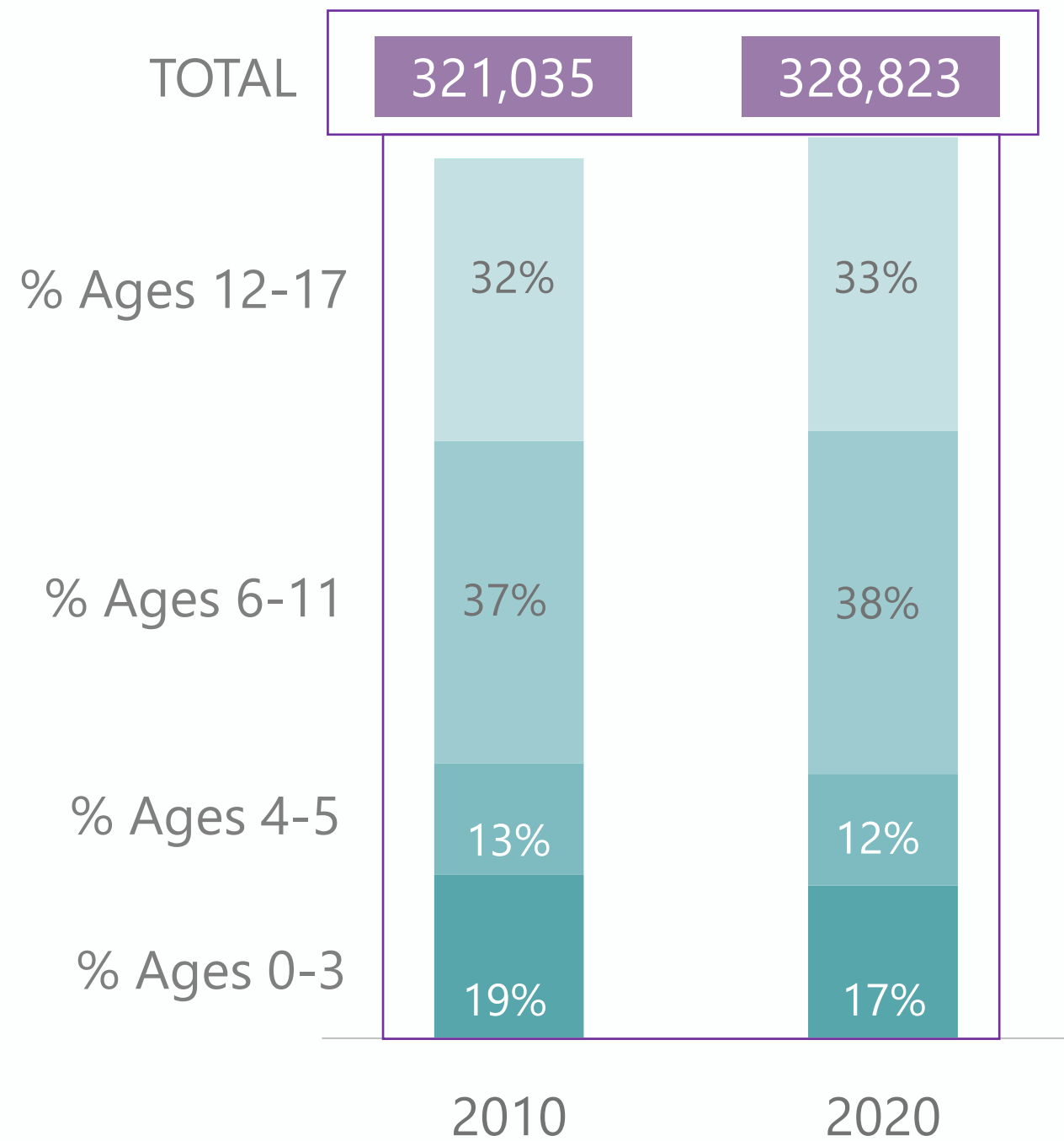

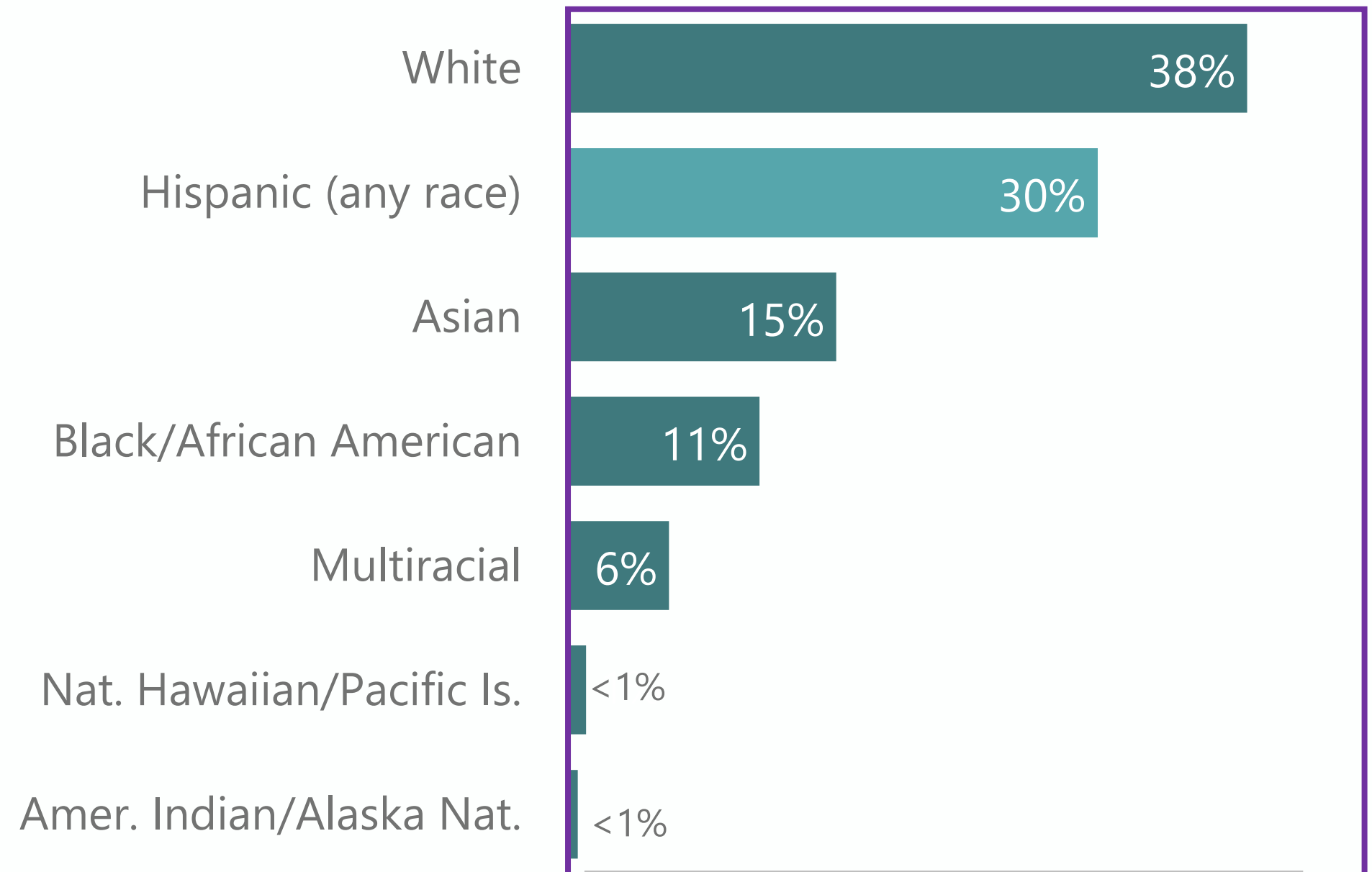
Sacramento Co. Population Trends

Percent of 2020 Total Population Ages 0-18 By Race and Ethnicity

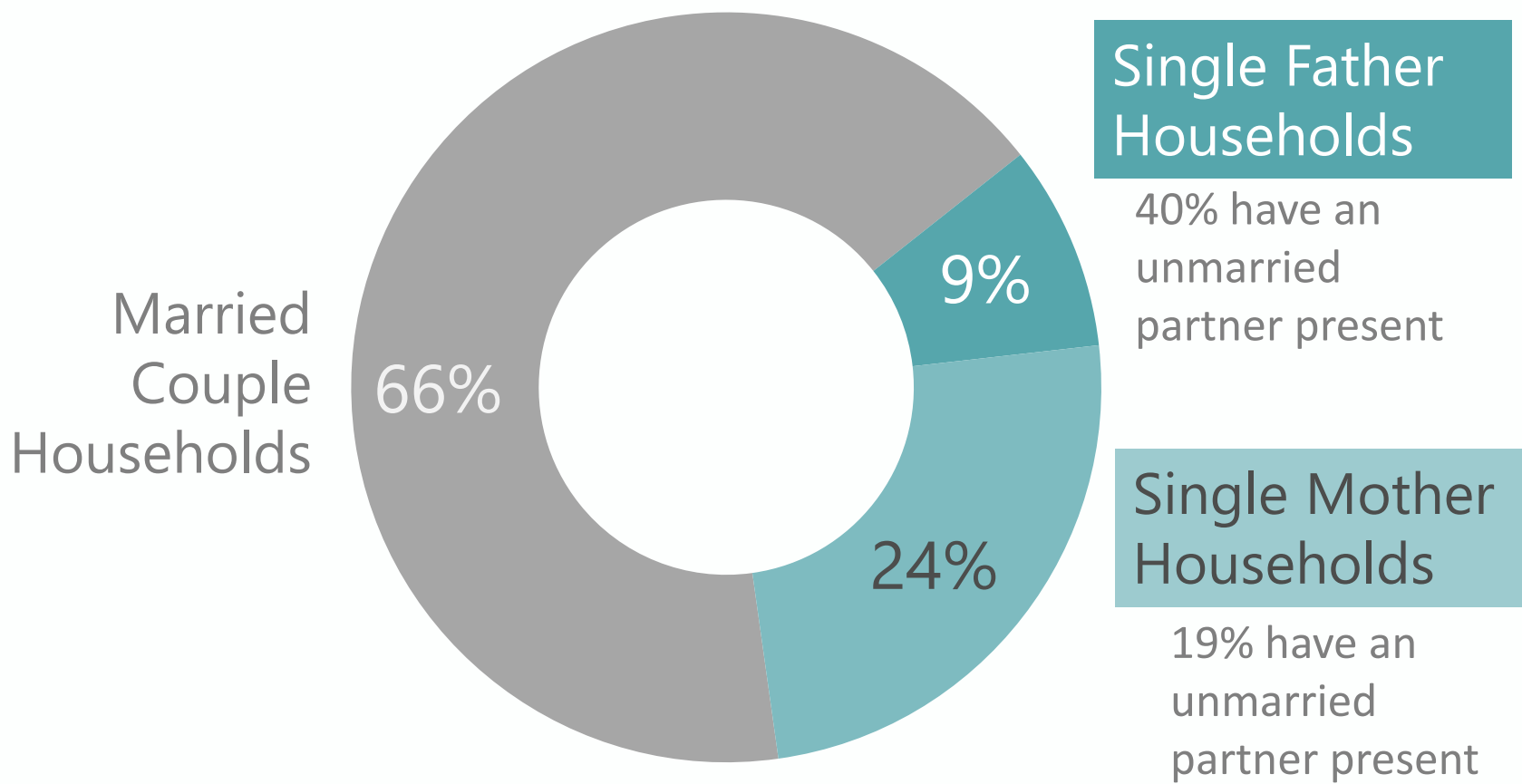

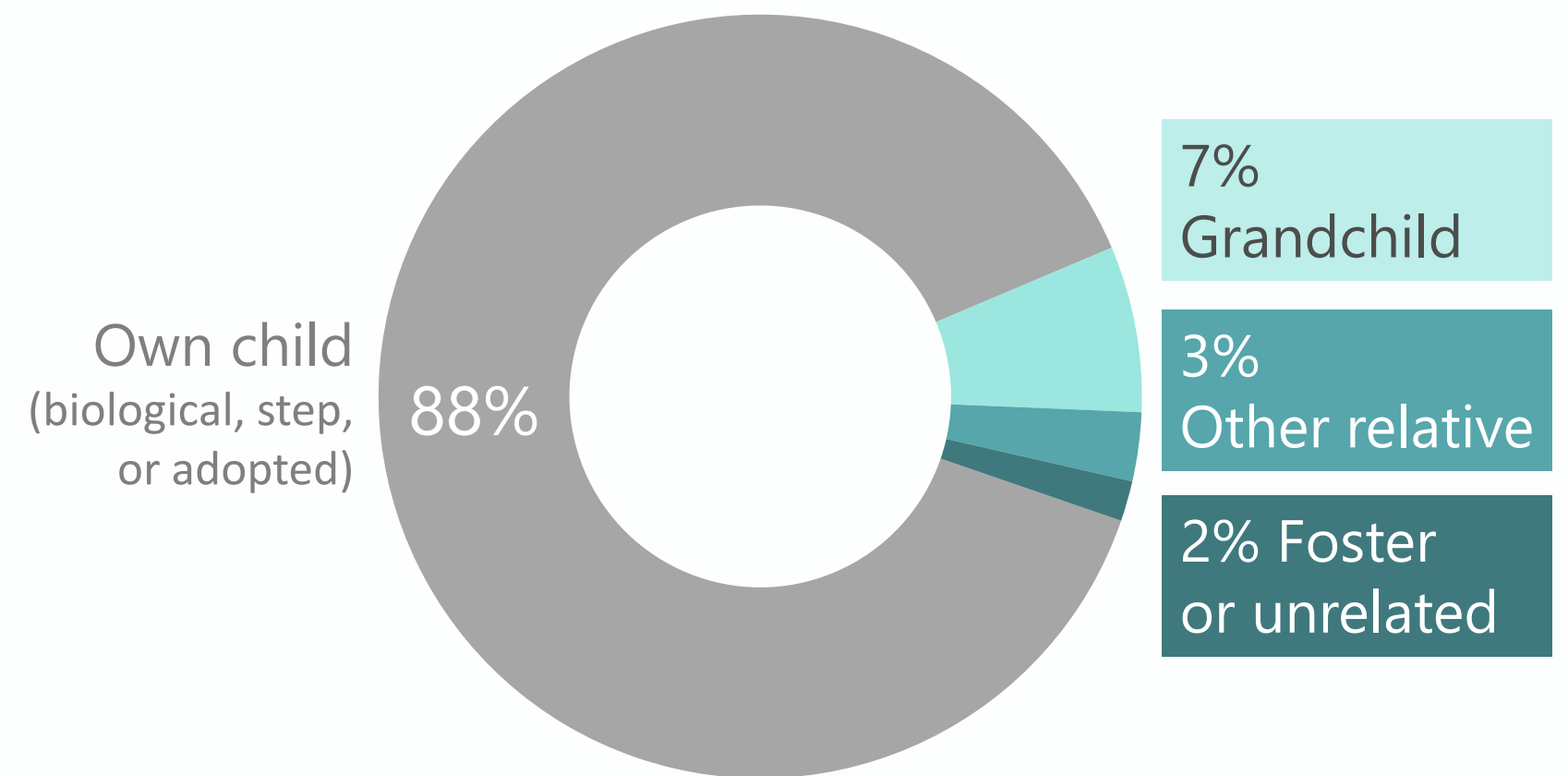
Sacramento Co. Household Types

Child's Relationship to Head of Household

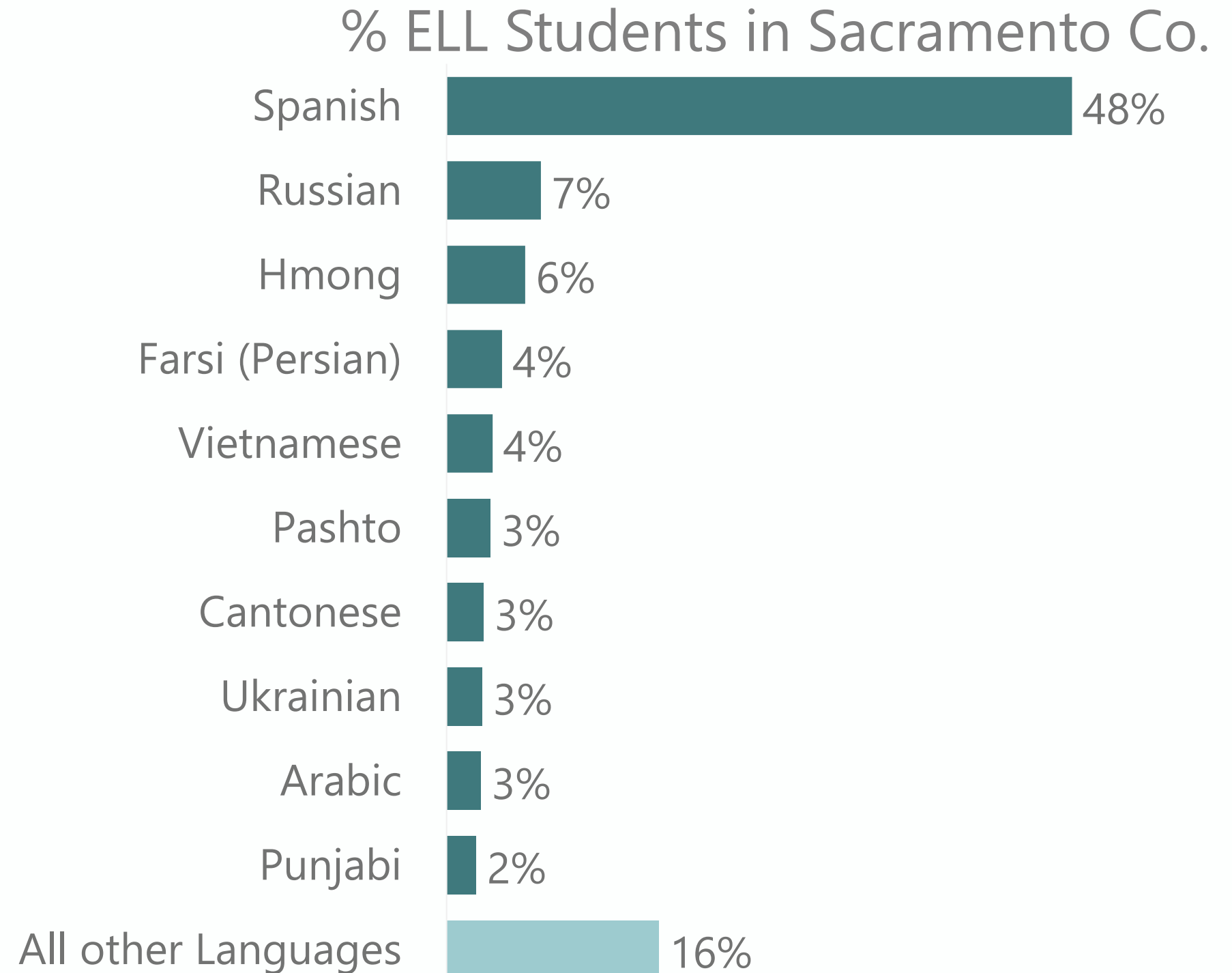

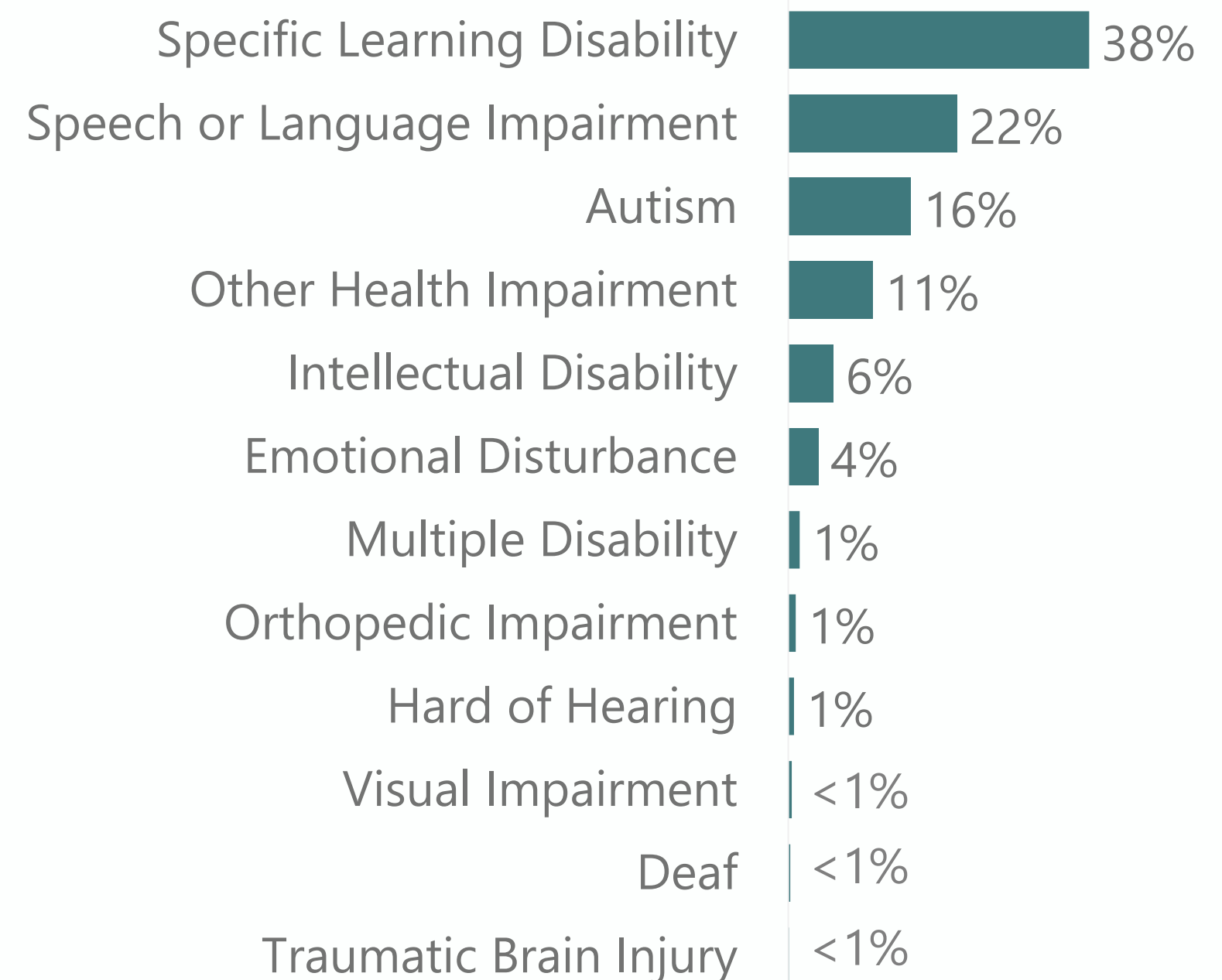

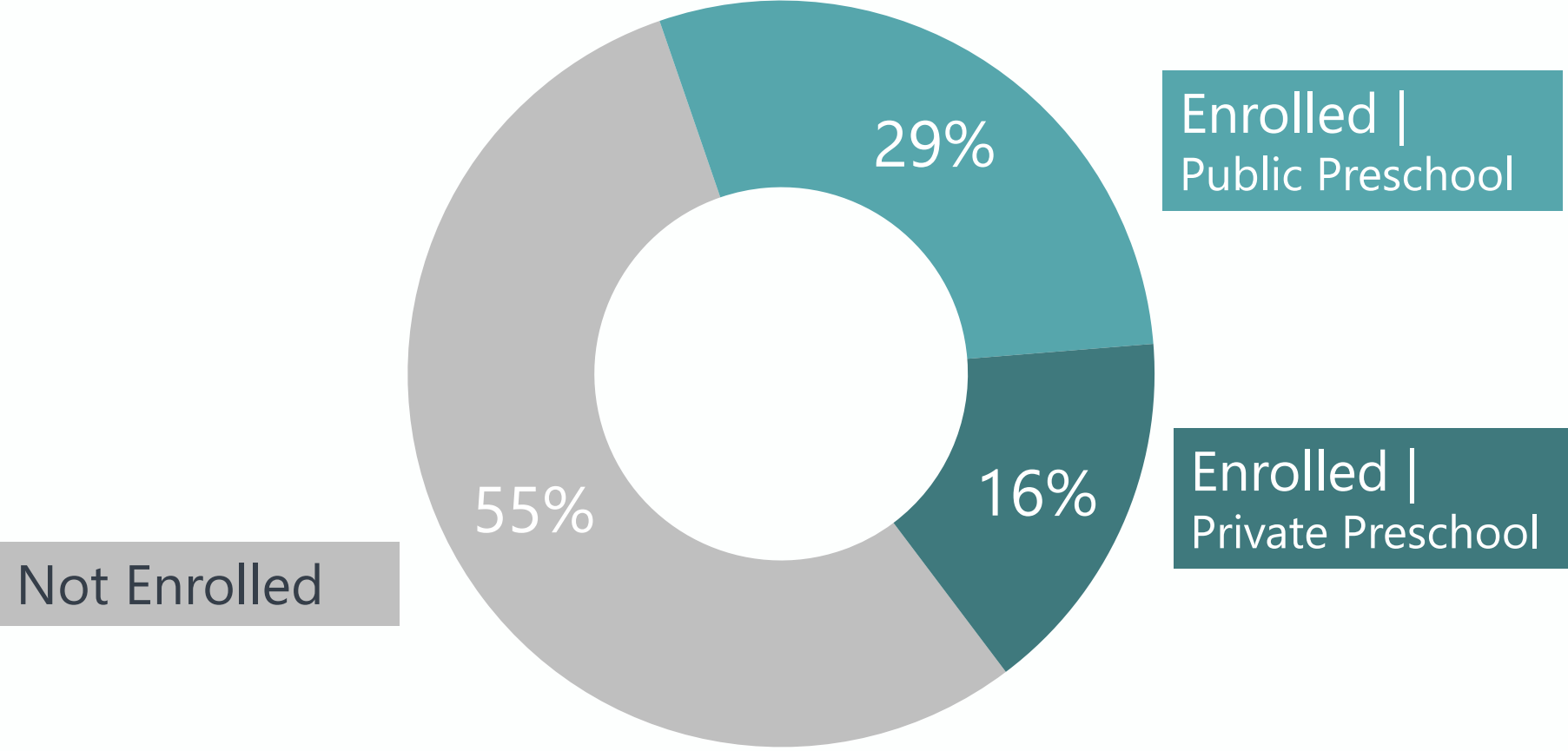

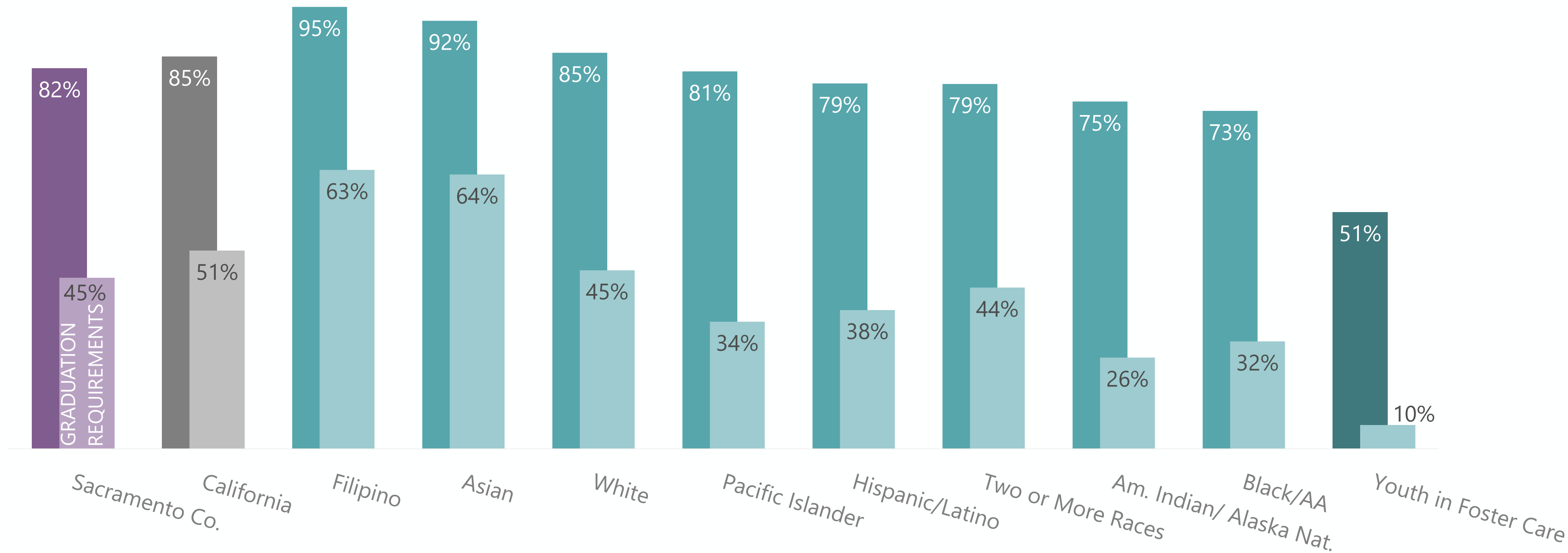

% of Children Enrolled in Preschool



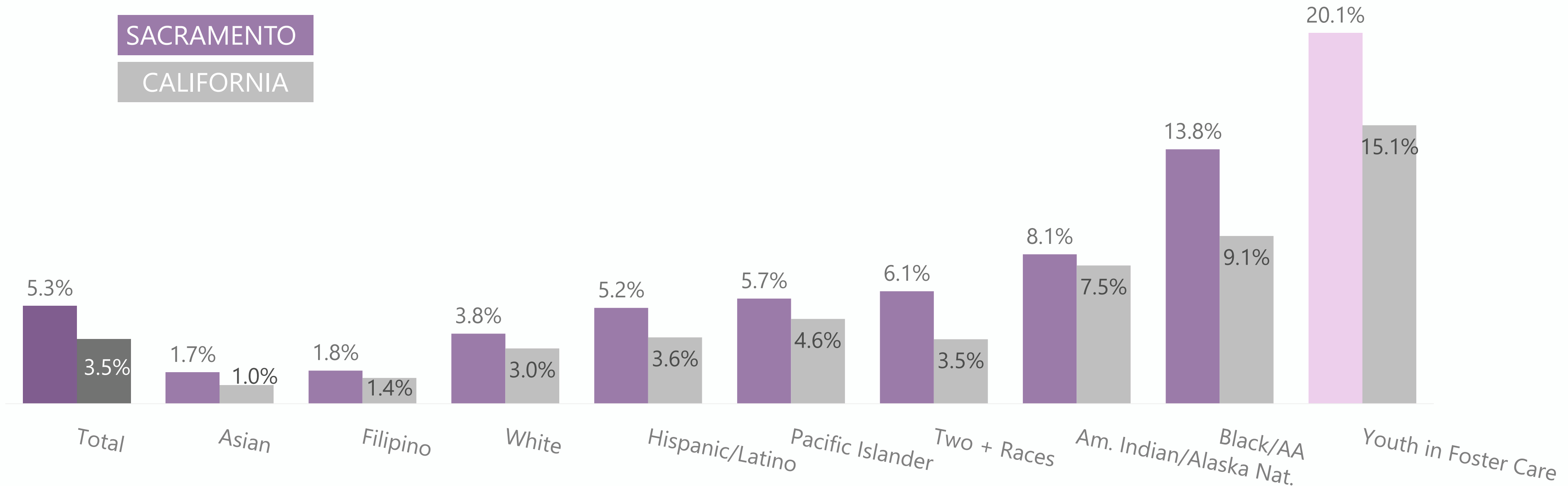
Sacramento Co. High School Students

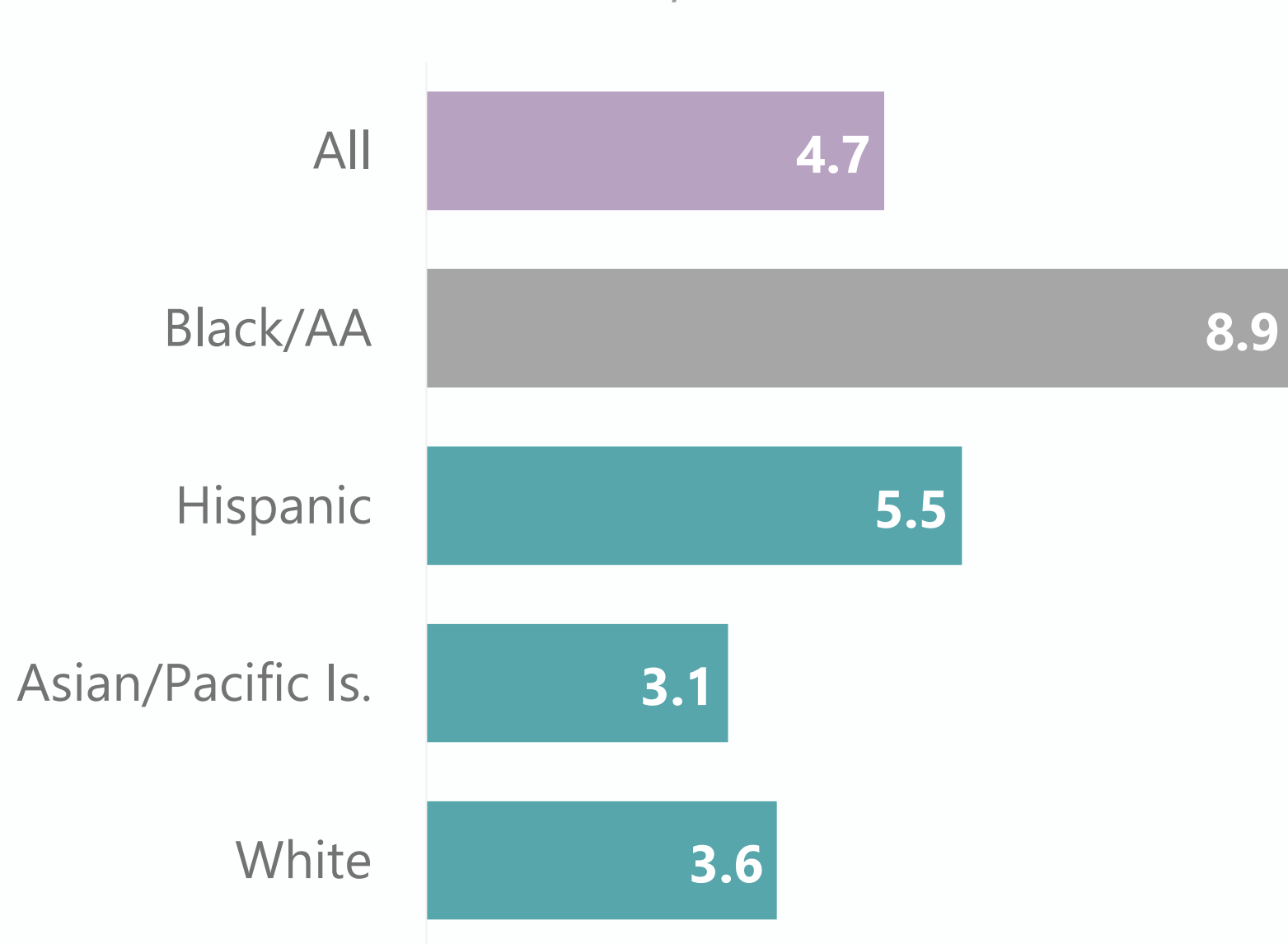

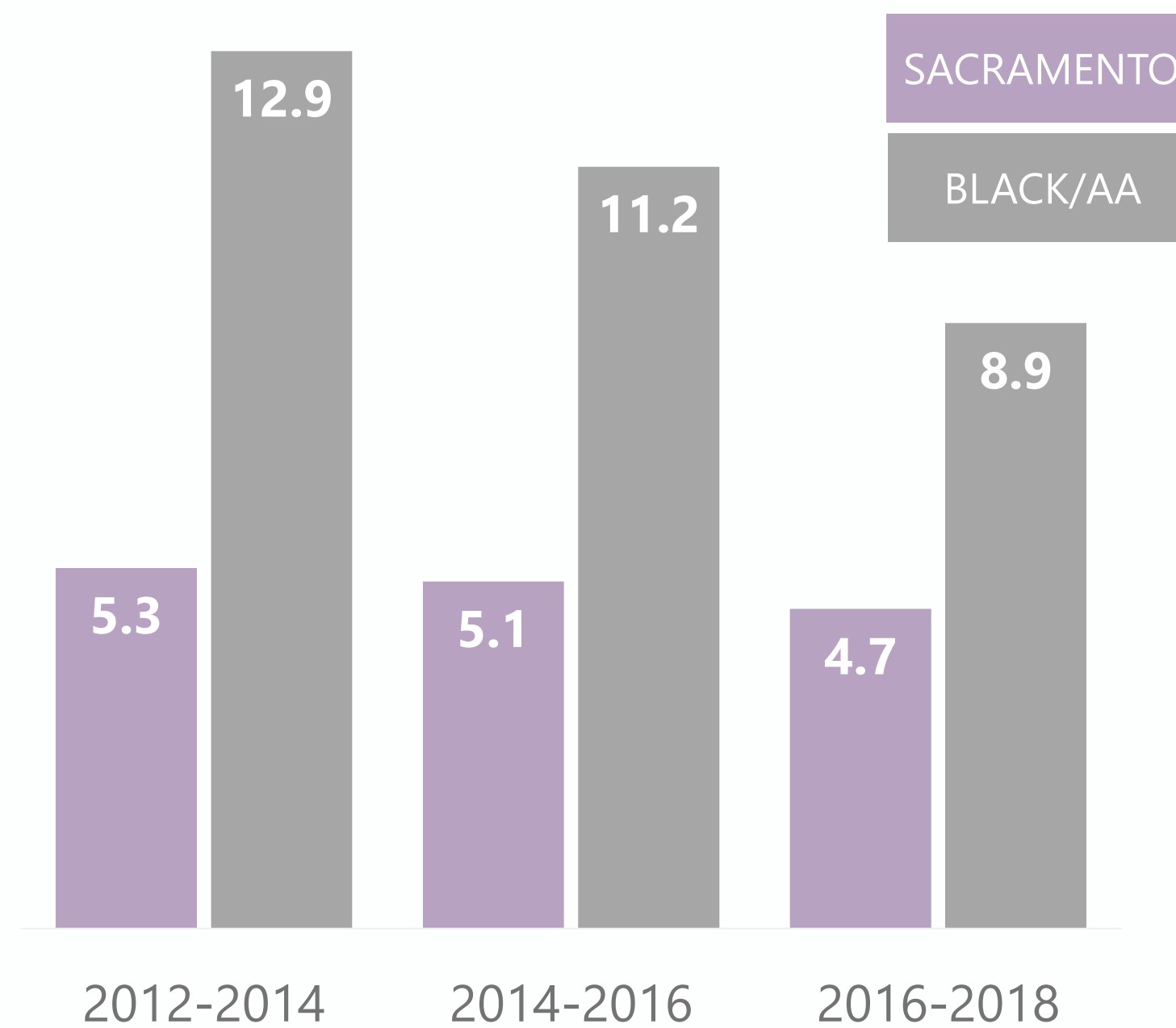
Sacramento Co. Infant Death Rates

Infant Death Rates by Race/Ethnicity 2016/18

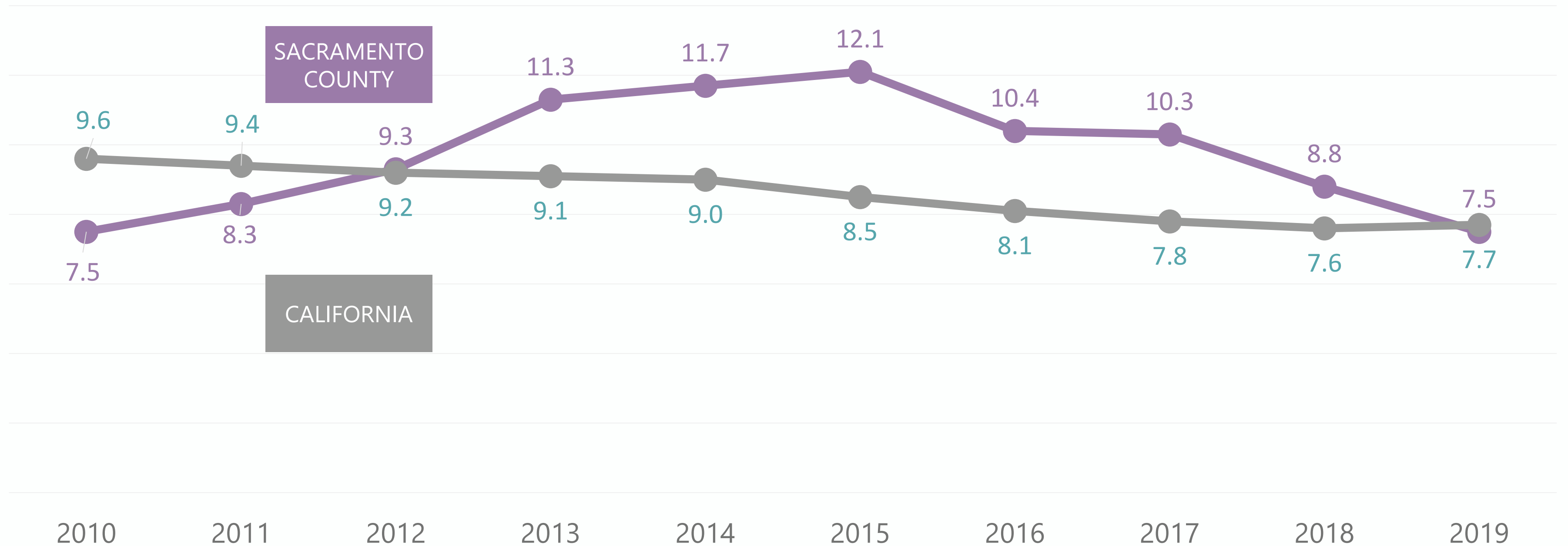


Comparison Over Time 2012/14 – 2016/18

Sacramento Co. Homelessness

Families & Children

20% of those who reported homelessness were **families with children.**

52% of the families who reported homelessness were **unsheltered.**

This is **5x higher than the national average** of 5-10% of families reporting being unsheltered.

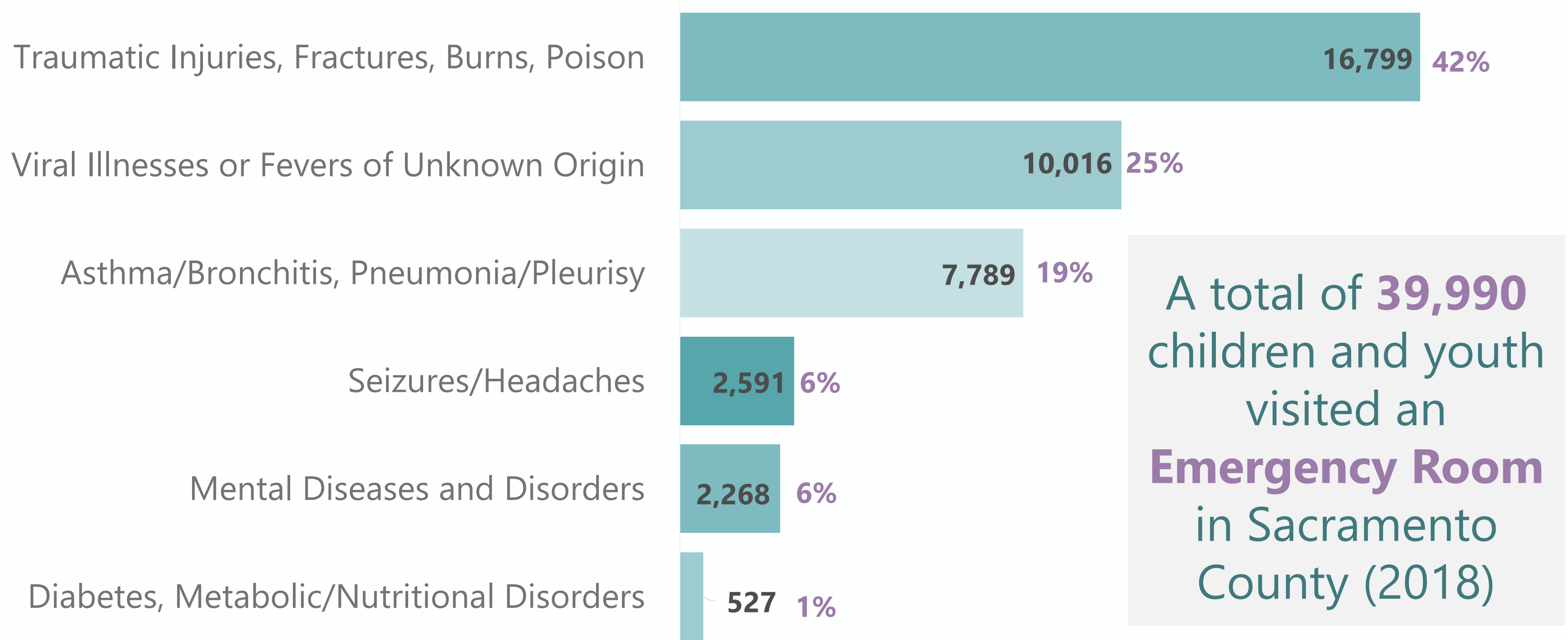


10,470 students were experiencing homelessness or **4.0% of all enrolled students** in the county.

This is compared to **California**, which report a total of **4.3%** of all students experiencing homelessness.

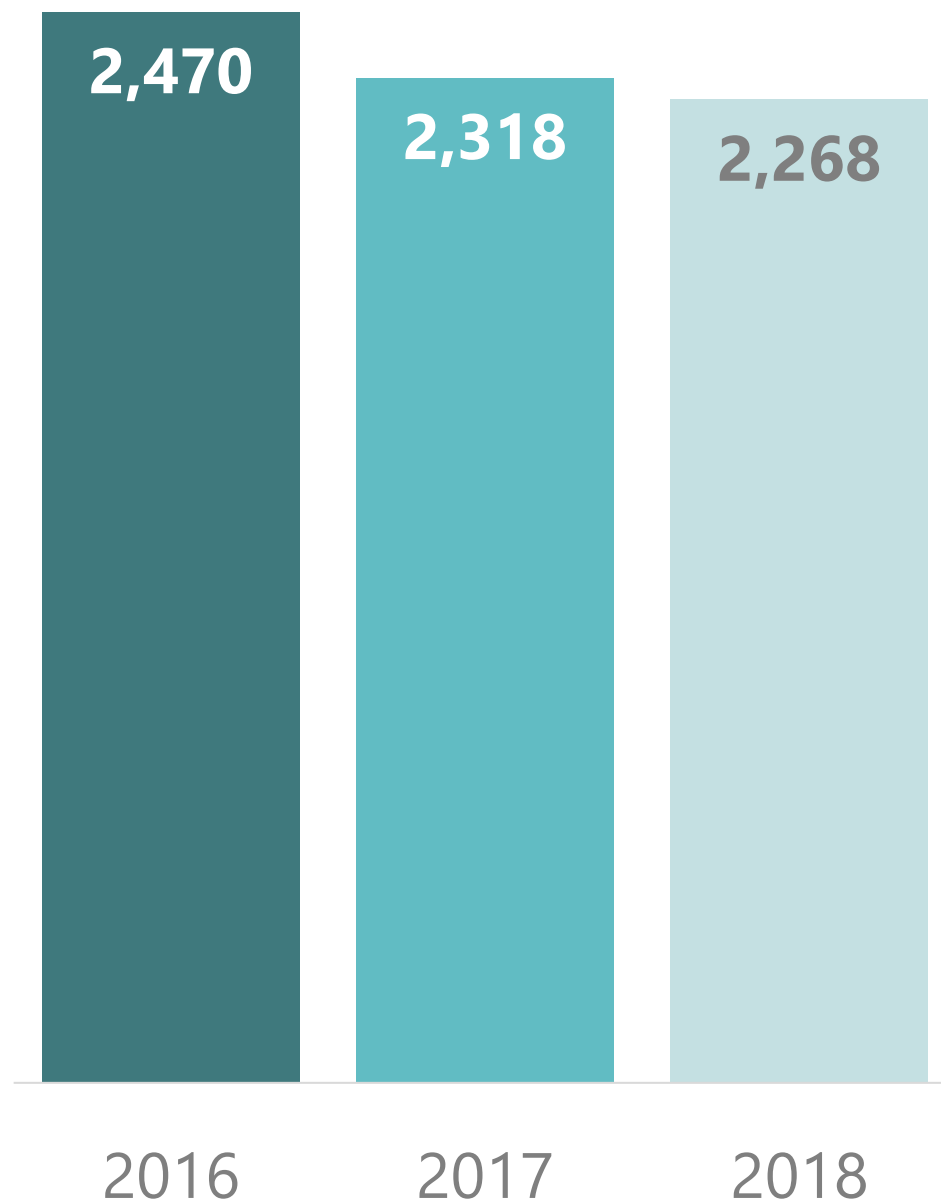

Children 0-17



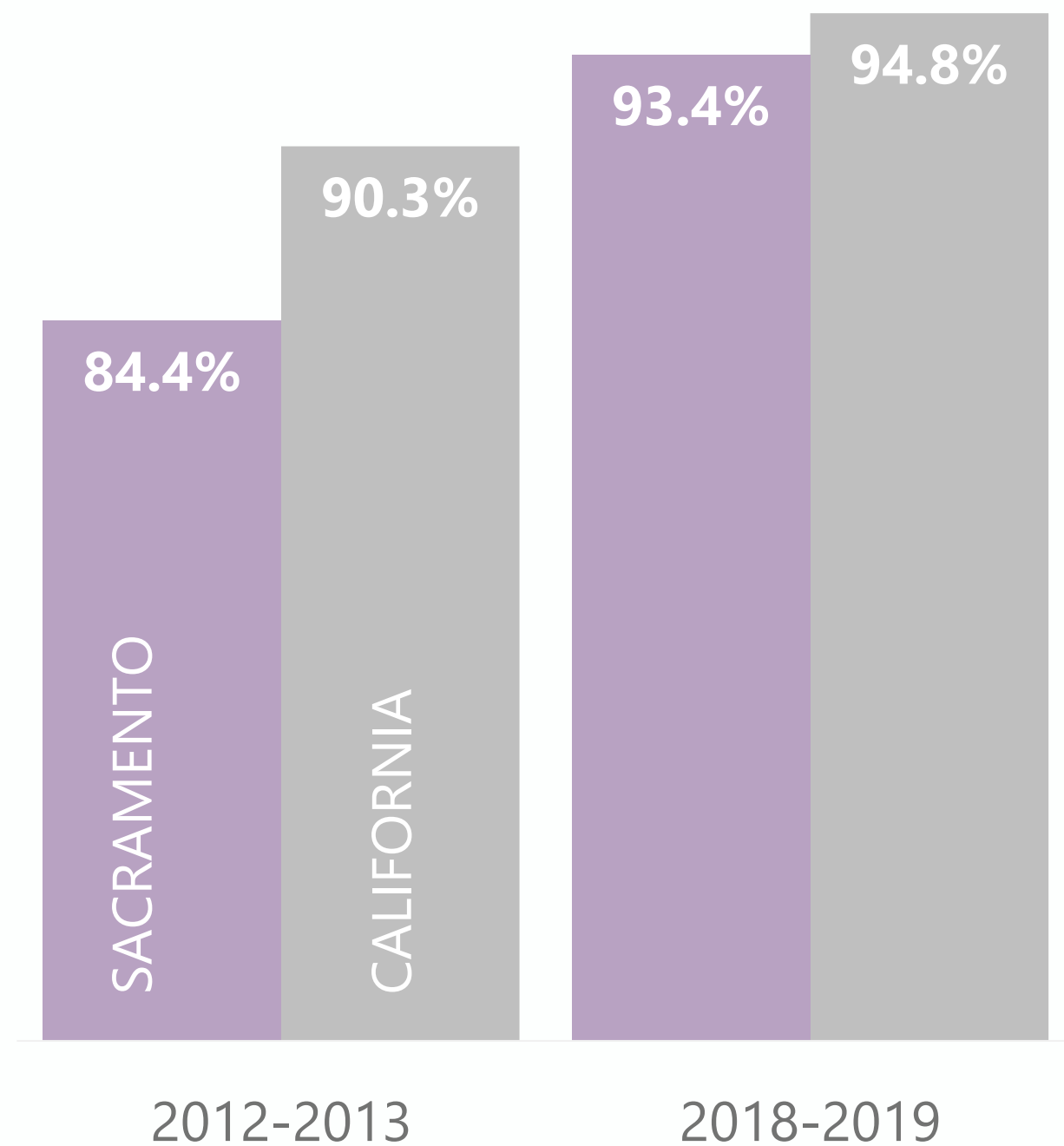
Child & Youth Mental Health Care Capacity

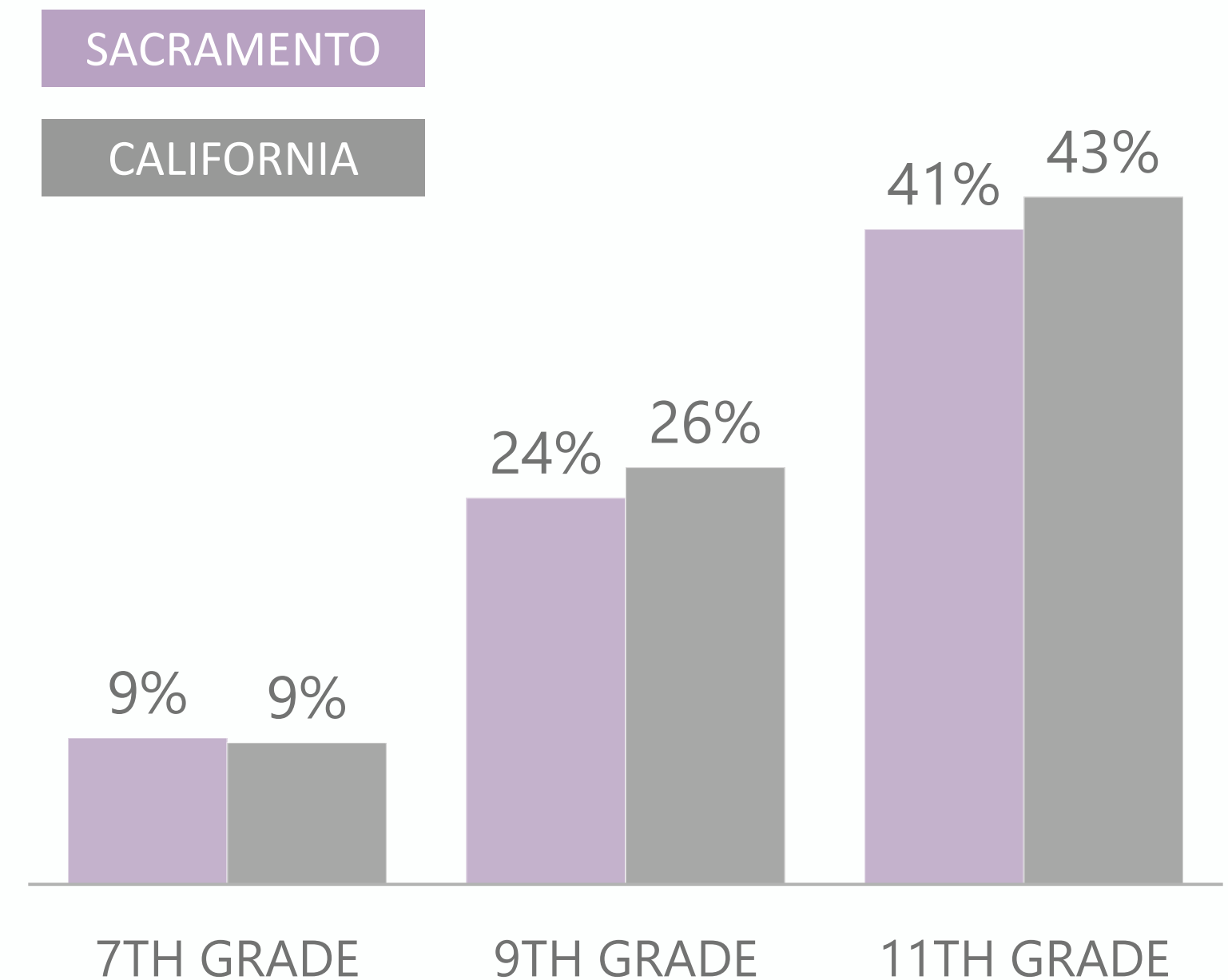
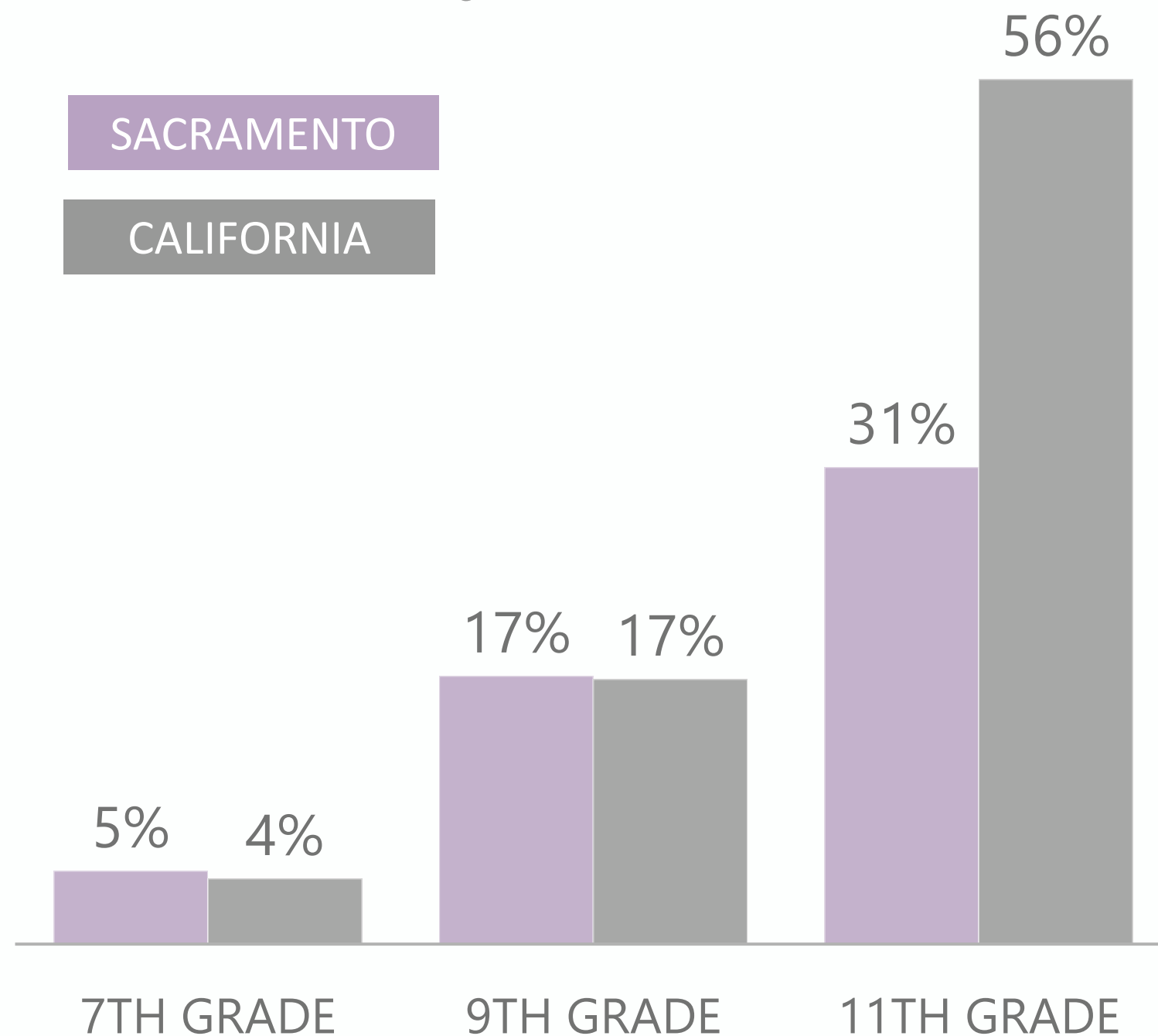


Sacramento Co. Marijuana/Alcohol Use

Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs)

A traumatic experience in a person's life occurring before the age of 18 that the person remembers as an adult.

Research has found a **relationship between childhood exposure to traumatic events and health risk behavior and disease in adulthood**

# ACEs reported	SACRAMENTO	CALIFORNIA
0 ACEs	33%	36%
1-3 ACEs	48%	46%
4+ ACEs	19%	16%
