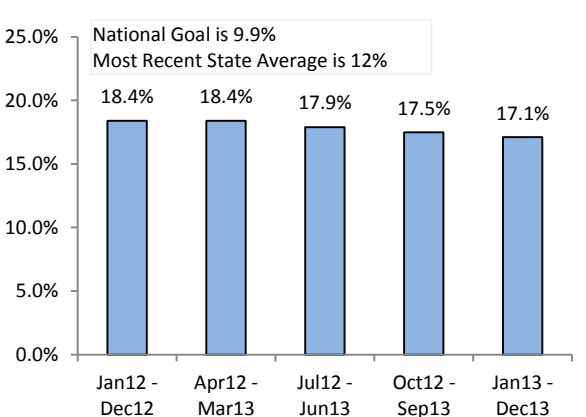
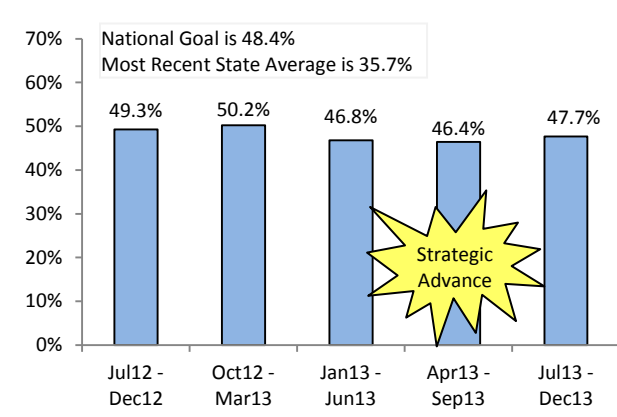
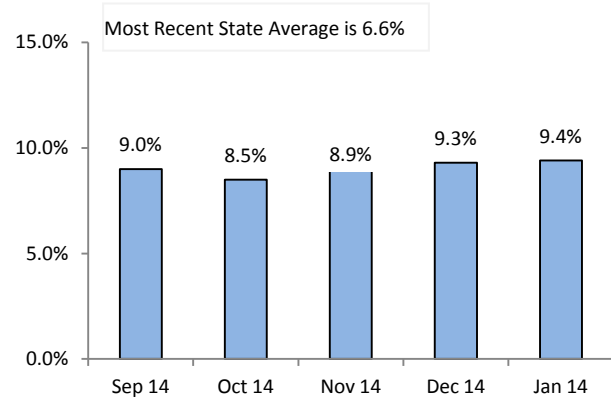
SAFETY - Children have the opportunity to grow up with their families and are removed from their families only when necessary to keep them safe

- 1. Safely decrease foster care population (out-of-home placements) (SafeMeasures)
- 2. Safely increase exits from foster care while decreasing entries (SafeMeasures)
- 3. (S1.1) Safely decrease reoccurrence of maltreatment within 6 months (SafeMeasures)



PERMANENCY - Children belong in safe & stable families

- 4. Decrease group home placements (for children in foster care) (SafeMeasures)
- 5. (C1.3) Improve timely reunification within 12 months (SafeMeasures)
- 6. (C1.4) Safely decrease re-entries into foster care (SafeMeasures)




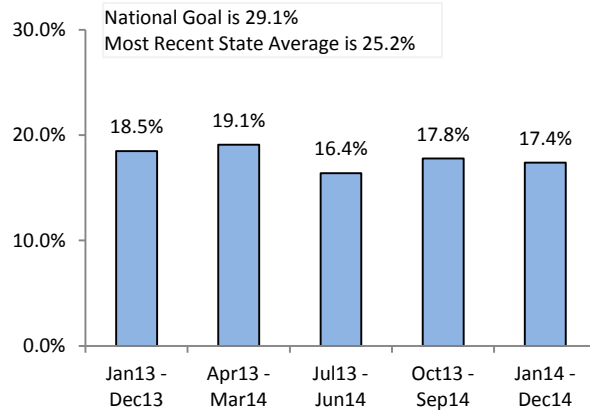

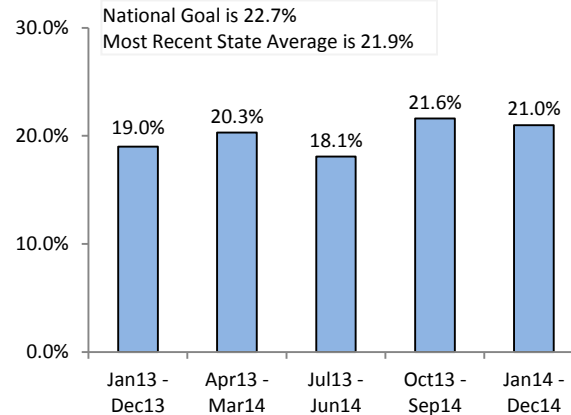

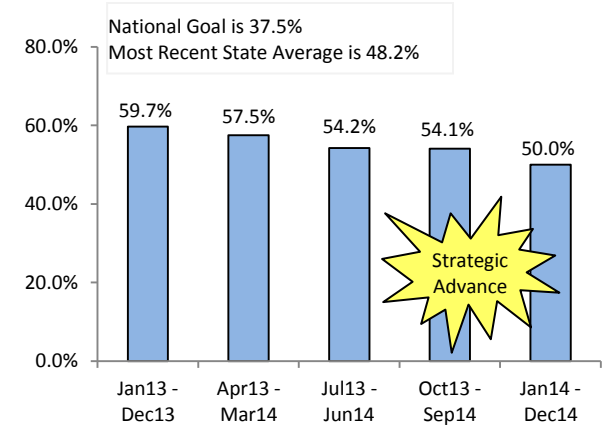
7. (C3.1) Increase the number of children achieving permanency within 12 months after being in care 24 months or longer. (SafeMeasures) 




8. (C2.3) Increase adoptions within 12 months for children in care 17 months or longer. (SafeMeasures) 

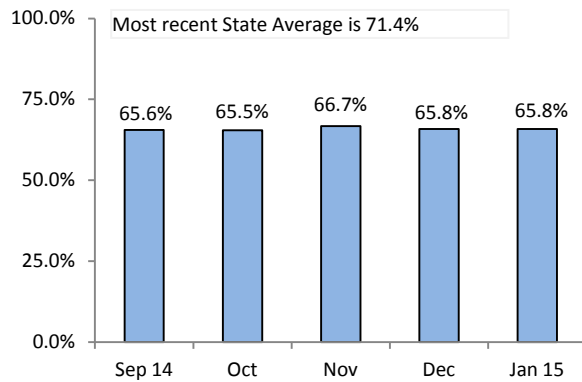



9. (C3.3) Decrease the number of children in care 36 months or more (Emancipated or age 18 in care) (SafeMeasures) 

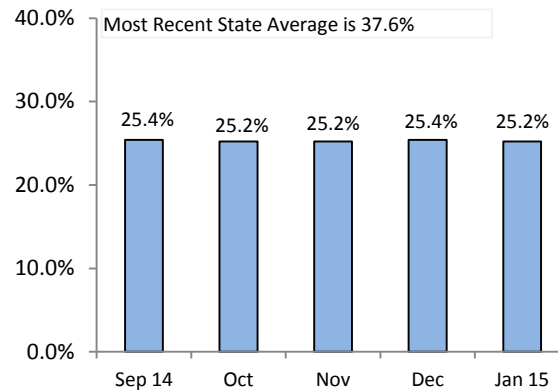


WELL BEING - Children receive supports that are trauma informed and focused on their physical health, emotional, educational and behavioral well-being
