Complete the form in full. Incomplete forms must be corrected and will delay the processing of your records request. If you have any questions about how to complete or submit the form, contact the CPS Gatekeeper of records at:

Every Requester:

- 1.** Complete the *Declaration Submitted By* box at the top of the form with your contact information. Fill in ALL information.
- 2.** Include the name of every child (minor) for whom you want records. The date of birth for every child is required. Information will only be released for children listed on the form.
- 3.** Fill in the case number if known. This can be left blank if not known
- 4.** Fill in your name in the blank section of the line that states, "I (write in your name), do hereby declare..."
